- Develop an annual congregational stewardship program based on ministry and facility plans.
- Ensure that facilities, human resources, and finances are appropriately and effectively supported and aligned to best meet the church's strategic goals.
- Ensure that appropriate processes, policies, controls, and oversight are in place to deliver on all financial, legal and operating standards (including, OHS, MERT Medical Emergency Response Team, Operations Support Team Security Team).
- Responsible for implementing sound IT practices.
- Leads Financial Stewardship Team.

- Team member of the Leadership Team at Southview alongside the Senior Pastor and the Pastors leading IN, OUT, UP, and Operations.
